Barnawapara Wildlife Sanctuary is situated in the Balodabazar district of Chhattisgarh. It falls under the Balodabazar Forest Division. It is one of the mesmerizing wildlife Sanctuary of the state Chhattisgarh. It is spread over an area of 244.66 km² and is located between 21° 81' and 21° 00' in the North latitude and 82° 22' and 82° 37' in the East longitude. It was notified vide Government of Madhya Pradesh (Forest Department), notification no. F/15/76/2/x/76/2010 on 27th of July 1976. Barnawapara has significant ecological significance, due to its large size and intermittent continuity with the Gomarda Wildlife Sanctuary. The Protected Area has considerable demonstrative value and attracts numerous visitors, owing to its accessibility from nearby towns and cities, especially the capital city Raipur. The summer temperature ranges from 40°C to 47°C, while the winters are quite chiller with the temperature dropping down to 5°C to 7°C. The geological formations of the northern portion of the sanctuary falls in the Chandrapur group, while the southern portion falls under the Raipur formation. While the geological formations of adjoining areas comprise of Granite and Gneiss. There are two perennial rivers that drains the area, viz. Balamdehi on the western fringes, and Jonk on the North- Eastern side. The area also

23rd Oct 2024 - Compile & sharing of butterflies lists and photographs with department & after that concluding session and departure to home with sweet memories & large experiences of Butterflies in Barnawapara.

----- Eligibility Criteria -----



- Participants must be able to walk minimum 10 KM to 15 KM in a day.
- Age limit for participants is 18-60 years.
- The participant should have basic knowledge of identifying the butterfly Species.

----- Selection Process -----

- Based on the information filled by the individuals in their registration form, team "Barnawapara Sanctuary Butterfly Meet 2024" will select the participants and their decision will be final.
- Incomplete forms will not be entertained. If someone tries to influence the selection process his/her registration will be treated as cancelled.
- Selected applicants will be informed through e-mail.

----- Do's & Don't -----



- You will at all times abide by the rules and regulations of the Forest Department.
- Use a field guide for correct identification of butterfly.
- Carry your basic medicines along with you since medical facilities are limited in the region.
- Do not wear brightly colour clothes, have dull colour or camouflage clothes.
- Smoking and Consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- Always follow and obey the instruction of the forest official or experts accompanying you.
- Do not leave the allotted track during survey.
- Do not collect anything from the forest.
- Maintain a safe distance from wildlife.
- Keep a track of time and ensure you return to your base camp at the pre-decided time.
- Good or record shots of unidentified or rare butterfly will be extremely helpful and necessary in some cases.
- Sharp image are not the intended output of the survey.
- Management of Barnawapara Sanctuary will not be responsible for any accidents during butterfly survey.
- Sanctuary will make simple arrangements of stay and food during the butterfly survey come with less expectations.
- Violation of any of the conditions mentioned above shall make the participants liable to intervention by the Forest Department.
